

HALLOWEEN - October 25, 2011

Design Rules: Exhibits are to be placed between 8 and 11 am. Entry tags and 3 x 5 cards will be furnished. Plant materials should be listed with each entry. Each design must include some fresh plant material. Creative designs may include dried painted/artificially colored plant material. Each designer can only enter one design in each category and must be the work of the exhibitor. Two Best of Show Ribbons will be awarded. One for classes 1-4 and one for classes 5-8.

1. "Indian Summer" – A novice design (for winners of less than 15 blue ribbons)
2. "Autumn's Treasures" - A traditional design including fruits, vegetables and/or grain
3. "Magic Wand" - A vertical traditional design
4. "Trick or Treat" – A small design – over 5" up to 12"
5. "Pumpkin Patch" – A design using gourds – SPECIAL CLASS**
6. "Spider Webs" – A creative design – Designer's choice
7. "Witchcraft" - A creative design
8. " The Magic of Halloween" – An illuminary design

Horticulture Rules: Exhibitors must furnish their own containers. Exhibits are to be placed between 8 and 10 am. Entry tags will be furnished. Place cultivar name on tag if known. Only entries with the cultivar name will be considered for the Best of Show award, but will be considered for the blue ribbon. All foliage on cultivar above water line should be left on stem. Decision of the judge is final. Each exhibitor may enter 2 exhibits in each class. Classes will be subdivided or combined as necessary by the show committee. One Best of Show ribbon will be awarded.
