DIVISION A: HORTICULTURE

Horticulture Rules:

- 1. All entries **must** be in place by 9:45 a.m. in the Trellis Gallery; Judging begins immediately at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. All entries **must** be grown by the Exhibitor.
- 3. All entries (except Classes 8, 9, and 10) must be displayed in a clear glass container provided by the Exhibitor.
- 4. To be eligible for BOS, all entries **must** be accompanied by an approved entry tag, complete with the Exhibitor's name, and both the Common Name and specific variety of the entry.
- 5. An Exhibitor may enter more than one entry in any given class; but only one variety per class.
- 6. The Flower Show Committee may subdivide classes if necessary.
- 7. All entries will be judged according to the OAGC Handbook, by an accredited OAGC judge.
- 8. The Judge's decision is Final.
- 9. All worthy awards will be as follows: 1st place blue ribbon, 2nd place red ribbon, 3rd place yellow ribbon. If the Judge so deems, an Honorable Mention may be awarded.
- 10. Best of Show Rosettes awarded to Best Horticulture Specimen and Best Container-Grown Plant.
- 11. All Junior entries must include the letter "J" after the Division letter.
- 12. All houseplants must have been grown by the Exhibitor for the last three months.

- Class 1. Tulips
- Class 2. Daffodils
- Class 3. Hyacinth
- Class 4. Any Other Spring Flowering Bulb (Allium, Amaryllis, Aneome, Camassia, Chionodoxa, Crocus, Dutch Iris, Eranthis, Erythonium (Dog's Tooth Violet), Fritillaria, Galanthus, Muscari (Grape Hyacinth), Iris danfordiae, Iris reticulate, Leucojum, Ornithogalum, Osalis, Puschkinia, Scilla) Exhibits should be groups of 3 the same color, at the same stage of maturity, the same size and uniformity.
- Class 5. Any Other Spring Flower
- Class 6. Flowering Tree Branch, under 15"
- Class 7. Flowering Shrub Branch, under 12"
- Class 8. Flowering Houseplant (**must** be in bloom) –one plant in container under 20 inches diameter
- Class 9. Spring flowering bulb garden –at least 3 different bulbs in bloom
- Class 10. Foliage Houseplant –one plant in container under 20 inches diameter

DIVISION B: ARTISTIC DESIGNS

Artistic Design Rules:

- 1. All entries **must** be in place by 9:45 a.m. in the Trellis Gallery; Judging begins immediately at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. All work **must** be completed by the Exhibitor.
- 3. All entries **must** be accompanied by an approved entry tag, completed with accurate information. This includes the Exhibitor's name, and the correct Division and Class numbers for the entry.
- 4. A 3" x 5" card listing the plant materials must accompany each exhibit. Must be legible.
- 5. Plant materials may be from any source. Either dried or fresh plant materials may be used. NO plant on the conservation list may be used. No dyed plant material may be used; however, dried plants may be painted.
- 6. All designs will be judged according to the OAGC Handbook, by an accredited OAGC judge.
- 7. The Judge's decision is Final.
- 8. All worthy awards will be as follows: 1st place will receive a blue ribbon, 2nd place will receive a red ribbon, 3rd place will receive a yellow ribbon. If the Judge so deems, an Honorable Mention may be awarded.
- 9. A Best of Show Rosette will be awarded to Best Artistic Design.
- 10. All Junior entries must include the letter "J" after the Division letter.
- 11. NO ONE except the Judge, Flower Show Chair and Clerk are permitted on the Flower Show Floor at the time of judging.
- 12. The Flower Show Chairman and OAGC Region 6 cannot be held accountable for any loss or damage to the exhibitor's personal property.
- 13. All adult and Junior exhibitors must conform to these rules.

- Class 1. "The Tall Trees" NOVICE a designer who has not won 3 blue ribbons. A Parallel Design.
- Class 2. "Oriental Garden" A design in the Oriental manner.
- Class 3. "Button Mushroom" A miniature design, must be under 5 inches in any direction. Incorporate one or more buttons.
- Class 4. "Baboo Grove" A Creative Spatial Thrust design. See page 111 of the E&J handbook.
- Class 5. "Welcome Spring!" A Traditional Design using spring colors.
- Class 6. "Trellis Gallery" A Creative Design. Accessories permitted.
