

**2023 OAGC proposed By-law Changes to be approved at OAGC Annual Meeting (OAGC 2023 Convention)**

**Article III, Membership**

**Section 5:** Member-at-large now becomes “individual member”. “A person may hold membership as an individual member. Anyone may become an individual member by sending name, address and required annual dues (see Article XI Section 3) to The Association’s membership chair. The individual member will receive The Association’s official publication and may participate in state and regional meetings and activities, but is not entitled to vote at annual meetings nor be eligible for election to state or regional offices, nor to become an accredited judge”.

**Article XI, Dues**

**Section 3:** Member-at-large now becomes “individual member”. “The annual state dues for an individual member shall be the current dues at the time, determined periodically by the voting delegate(s) from each club at the annual convention. These dues shall be sent to the membership chair of The Association on or before October 1 of each year. Dues will not be pro-rated for new individual member joining after October 1”.
