**Special Classes: Roses**

Class 001: Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora, 1 stem, foliage attached, disbudded

Class 002: Floribunda, 1 spray or stem, foliage attached

Class 003: Miniature, 1 stem, foliage attached, disbudded

**Perennial Cut Specimens,**

One stem, foliage attached, disbudded unless specified

Class 004: Allium, 1 bloom

Class 005: Brunnera, 1 bloom spike and 1 leaf, not disbudded

Class 006: Coreopsis, 3 blooms

Class 007: Clematis, 1 bloom

Class 008: Daylily, 1 scape, not disbudded

Class 009: Lamprocapnos spectabilis (Bleeding heart), 1 stem, not disbudded

Class 010: Perennial Dianthus, 1 bloom

Class 011: Echinacea (Purple Cone Flower), 1 flowering stem, any color

Class 012: Digitalis (Foxglove), 1 flowering spike, not disbudded

Class 013: Hesperis (Dame's Rocket), 1 stem with flower cluster, not disbudded

Class 014: Heuchera (Coral Bells), 1 bloom spike and 1 leaf, not disbudded

Class 015: Iris, 1 stem, any variety

Class 016: Poppy, Perennial, 1 flowering stem

Class 017: Peony, 1 flowering stem

Class 018: Yarrow, 1 flowering stem, not disbudded

Class 019: Fern, 1 frond

Class 020: Hosta, Miniature, green or blue, up to 6.0 sq. in.

Class 021: Hosta, Small, variegated with blue or green margin 6.0 to 25 sq. in

Class 022: Hosta, Medium, variegated with yellow or white margin, 25 to 81 sq. in

Class 023: Hosta, Large or Giant, Greater than 81 sq. in.

Class 024: Any other perennial, not listed above

## Container Grown Plants

Class 031: Closed Terrarium, container not to exceed 12" in width

Class 032: Patio Pot, Annuals, Mixed Varieties, Outside of container not to exceed 18" in width/depth

Class 033: Patio Pot, Variety of Foliage Plants, Outside of container not to exceed 18" in width/depth

Class 034: Begonia, multiple plants, same variety, container not to exceed 12" in width/depth

Class 035: Metal junk planting, Not to exceed 18" in width/depth

Class 036: Houseplant, any variety of houseplant, container not to exceed 14" in width/depth

## Artistic Flower Design

Class 037: Tea Party: Miniature Design not exceeding 5" in any direction

Class 038: The Forest: Parallel Design not exceeding 16" in width

Class 039: Fireworks: Vertical Design

Class 040: Summer Reflections: Ikebana Design, not exceeding 24" in width/depth

### General Rules

1. Entries are open to the public, all ages qualify. Entry fee is \$1/item.
2. EXHIBITS MUST BE TICKETED AND REGISTERED BY 11:30 A.M.
3. There will be no grooming or artistic design set up after 11:30 A.M on the day of show.
4. Open judging by an accredited O.A.G.C. judge will begin at 12:00 P.M. with quiet prevailing during judging. Exhibitors and interested persons are encouraged to attend judging. There will be no discussion about the exhibits with the judge prior to and during judging.
5. 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place winners are awarded at the discretion of the judge in each class. Any award may be withheld at the discretion of the judge. "Best of Show" awards will be given by the judge in all four divisions: Cut specimens, container grown plants, artistic designs, and photos.
6. Premiums will be awarded at the conclusion of the show. If not picked up by 4 pm, the premium money will be returned to the Fleurette Garden Club general fund.
7. Premiums: 1st -\$2.00; 2nd-\$1.50; 3rd -\$1.00

**The Fleurette Garden Club will not be responsible for any entries left after 3:30 pm. Exhibits, including photos, not picked up will be trashed unless other arrangements are made.**

### Horticulture Rules

1. ALL CUT SPECIMANS MUST BE GROWN BY EXHIBITOR. Container plants must be potted by and in possession of exhibitor at least 30 days prior to show.
2. Exhibitors may make two entries in Rose and Perennial Cut Specimen classes.
3. Tags will be available the day of the show and should be placed on the exhibits before the entries are brought to the registration table.
4. Horticulture exhibits must be staged in clear glass containers provided by the exhibitor. Containers should be sturdy enough to hold the entry in an upright display.
5. All exhibits should be named if known. Only correctly named exhibits will be eligible for first place and Best of Show Award.
6. Wedges are allowed in horticultural exhibits as long as the wedge does not distract from the entry.

### Artistic Design Rules

1. Plant material for artistic design may be secured from any source. No artificial plant material will be permitted. No painted or artificially colored fresh plant material and no cut fruits or vegetables are permitted in artistic designs. Use of the American Flag is not permitted in any arrangement, Painted dried material, accessories and line material will be permitted. Plant, dried and line material must be stated on a 3x5 card or listed on the "Entry Description" portion of the entry tag.
2. Exhibits are displayed at the exhibitor's risk. Accessories and containers should be labeled with the owner's identification.

### Photography Display Rules

1. All photographs must have been taken by the exhibitor
2. All photographs must measure 4"X6" and must be mounted on a 5"X7" whiteboard.
3. Exhibitors may make only one entry per class
