- The amount of scholarship will be given directly to the recipient to use for tuition, fees, books and related supplies. A <u>Proof-of-Use</u> document, accompanied by receipts, must be submitted to the OAGC Foundation by the prescribed time.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant need not be a resident of Ohio.
- Applicant must attend or plan to attend a public college, university or technical school in the state of Ohio or a public college, university or technical school participating in the Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP) who have a reciprocal tuition agreement with Ohio.
- Applicant must submit proof of serious interest and intent to pursue a career in one of the fields listed above and a letter stating such must accompany the application.
- Applicant must submit proof of previous scholastic record of sufficient caliber to indicate their ability to succeed in their chosen field.
- Applicant must provide letter of acceptance from an accredited college or technical school.
- A letter of recommendation must accompany the application.
- Eligibility is determined solely by the scholastic ability and serious career intent of the applicant without regard to race, gender, age, creed and/or economic status.
- Applicant or applicant's family may or may not be associated in some manner with The Ohio Association of Garden Clubs, Inc.; such is not required and not precluded.
- If, for any reason, the recipient of the award should drop out of school before the year is completed, the recipient must immediately notify the OAGC Foundation Development Director in writing. Any unused portion of the award must be refunded to the OAGC Foundation and may not be carried over to the next year.
- Application must state the expected cost of one year's tuition, fees, books, and other related supplies required by the school.

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Scholarships are awarded to students who plan to attend a public college, university or technical school in the state of Ohio or a public college, university or technical school participating in the Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP) who have a reciprocal tuition agreement with Ohio and follow courses of study in the fields of horticulture, conservation, nature and beautification, landscape design, landscape contracting, commercial florist or floral arts.
